Discussions were held with the Harbormaster, Shellfish Warden, Board of Selectmen and Town Clerk. Meeting minutes have been compiled and are recorded at the Town Clerk's Office.

OBJECTIVES FOR THE WATERFRONT MANAGEMENT PLAN

The objectives for the WATERFRONT MANAGEMENT PLAN are as follows:

- Protection and Maintenance of Navigation.
- Providing Safe Mooring and Anchoring for Resident and Transient Vessels.
- Accommodating future growth and preserving the character of Mattapoissett Harbor and waters.
- Ensuring multiple uses of Mattapoissett Harbor and waters to avoiding user conflicts. Mattapoissett Harbor and waters supports a variety of uses such as recreational vessel use, personal watercraft and water skiing.
- Preserving Natural Resources and protecting natural shellfish and fish habitats such as areas with eelgrass.
- Supporting marine industry, which is critical to the recreational vessel use and needs to be served by current and future planning.

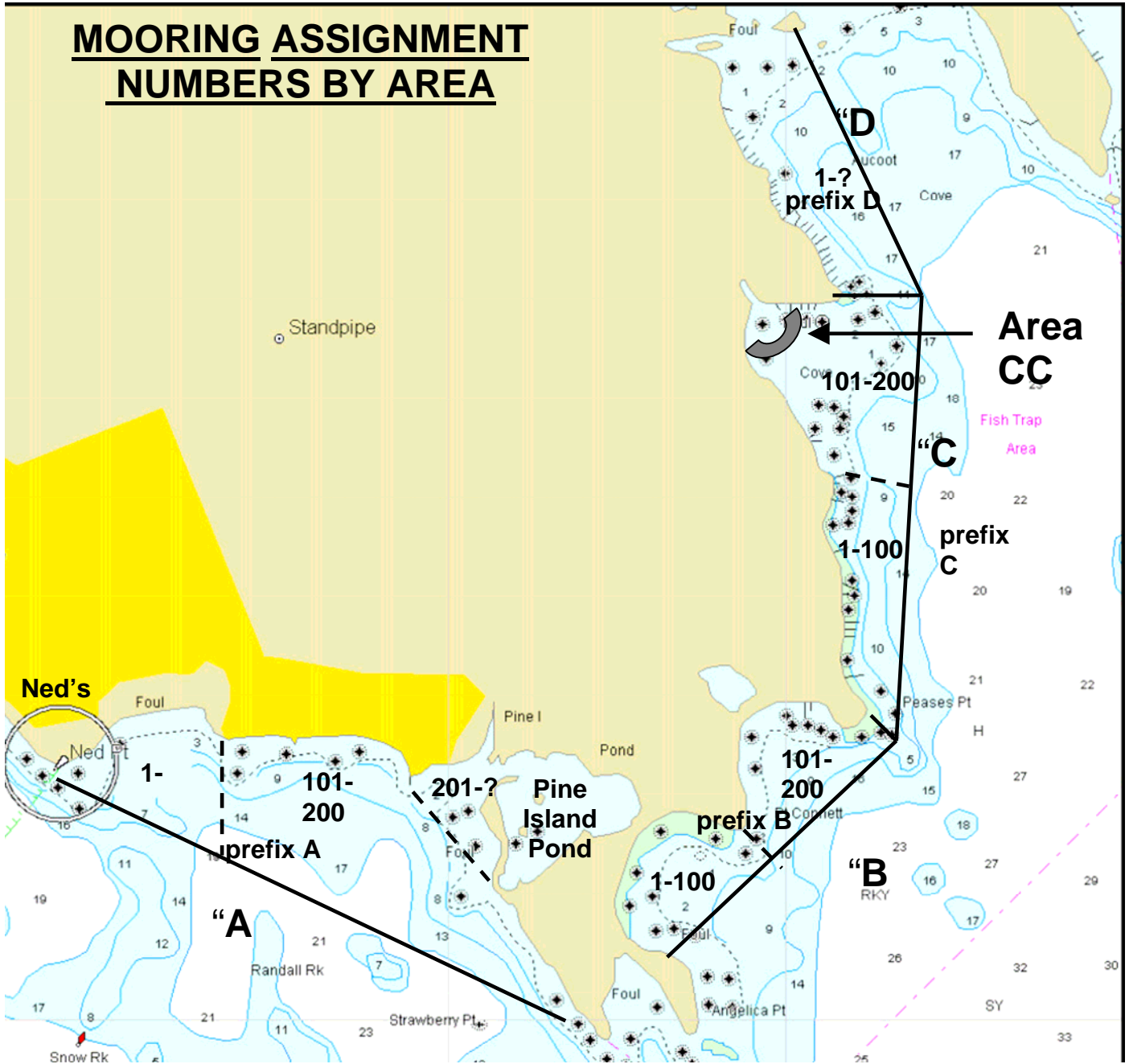

AREA NUMBER	NUMBER OF MOORGS	REASON FOR CLOSURE
1-100	100	Marshmeer shall be placed on grid. See note 1,3 & note 6 regarding Marshmeer. Molly's Cove is closed to new moorings. See note 7.
H	See note 2	This area is open to new moorings.
201-500	299	This area shall be placed on grid. The grid spacing shall be optimized for mooring quantity. See note 5.
501-851	See note 2	This area is on grid pursuant to section 7.1.2.
A1	100	This area is open to new moorings.
A101	99	This area is open to new moorings.
A201	-	This area is closed to new moorings.
B	See note 2	This area is open to new moorings. See note 3.
C1	100	This area is open to new moorings.
C101	99	This area is open to new moorings.
CC	-	This area is closed to new moorings.
D	100	This area is open to new moorings. The total quantity of moorings shall be capped at one hundred subject to review at that time. This area shall be placed on grid. Efforts shall be made to locate moorings as close to existing locations as deemed practical. See note 3.
E	See note 2	This area is open to new moorings.
F	12	This area shall be placed on grid. The total quantity of moorings shall be capped at twelve. See note 3.
G	See note 2	This area is open to new moorings. See note 3.

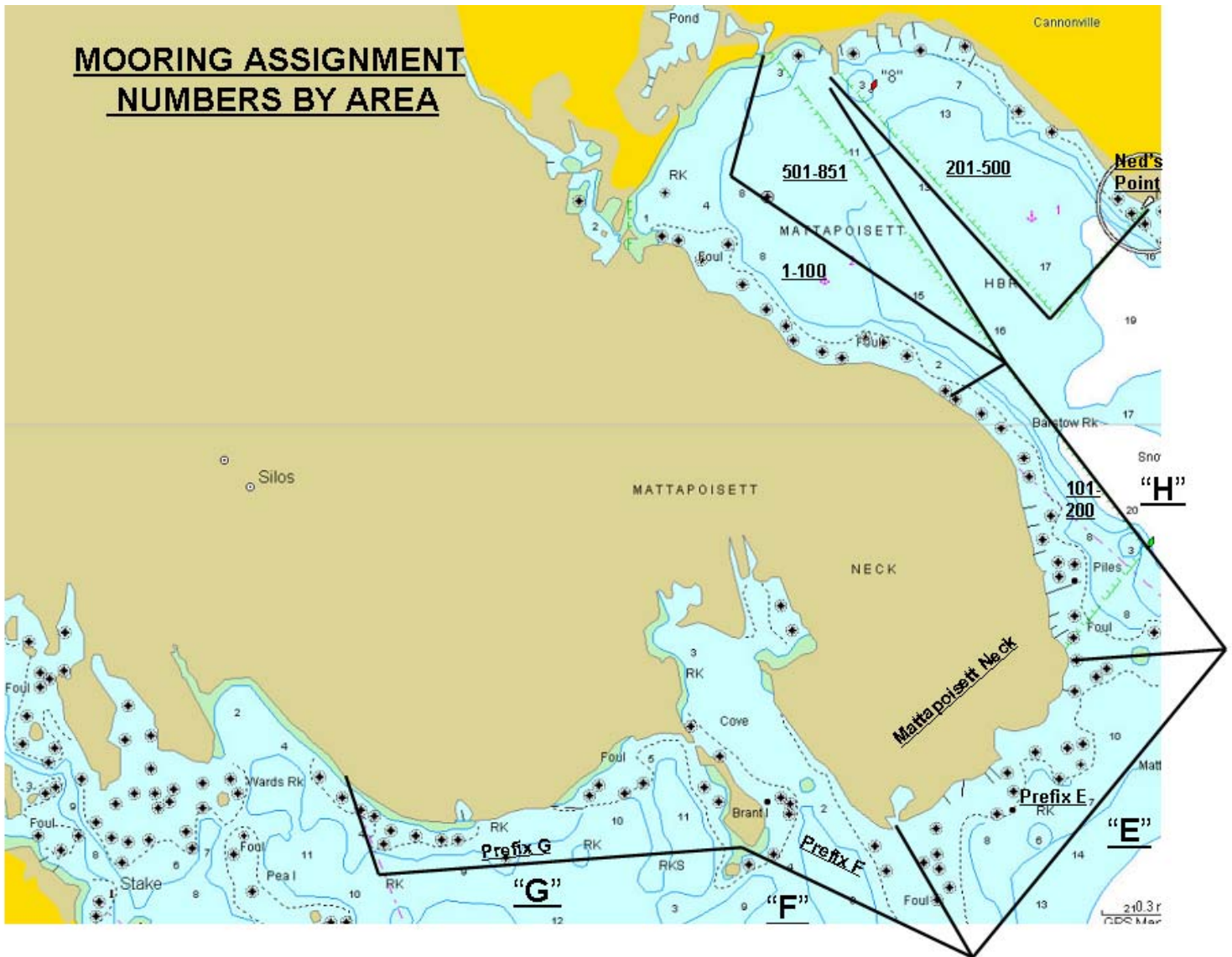
Note:

1. Consideration of mooring spacing shall take into account area used for anchorage and sailing.
2. Quantity of moorings is undetermined at present time.
3. Placement of moorings shall take eelgrass areas into consideration.
4. Business mooring reserved pool. The pool of business moorings is based upon a ratio of 10% of private moorings (inner harbor), ie., if there are ten private moorings then one mooring shall be added to business mooring pool. Location of business moorings shall be determined by Harbormaster.
5. New moorings off the town beach shall be held by the harbormaster for use by community-based programs.
6. An increase of two moorings per year over the next 5 years shall be permitted in the area known as Marshmeer.
7. The area known as Molly's Cove shall be closed to new moorings and remain open as a transient anchorage.
