

Timeline & Procedure for assignment of new wharf & dinghy spaces

Skiff & Dinghy – Space

1. Within the first week after new rules are approved an informational letter to be mailed to **all** skiff space holders. Letter to include copy of rule changes, and explanation that any boat under 10 feet **must** move to the dinghy dock boats exactly 10 feet have the choice of a skiff or dinghy space. Persons having a boat less than 10 feet wishing to retain a skiff space must have a boat 10 or longer by July 1, 2010. In either case everyone must respond within 30 days to facilitate assignment of new spaces.
2. All persons on the skiff wait list to get a letter explaining that they have a one time option to choose to stay on the skiff list or to go to the dinghy dock if they were planning to put a boat 10 feet or less in the skiff space. Also included in letter a copy of the rules, and an explanation that once on the dinghy dock there is no transfers back to the skiff list or to a skiff space. In either case everyone must respond within 30 days.
3. Dinghy Wait list and opening of all other lists; All list will reopen January 4 2010. Names will be accepted for these lists by the Town Clerk Monday through Thursday from 8:00AM to 4:00PM and Friday from 8:00 through 3:30PM. At 3:31 all names collected during this week for their respective lists will be drawn by lottery for placement on existing list in that category.

New Wharf Spaces

1. New wharf spaces will be assigned in the same manner as all other spaces as outlined in the Wharf, Mooring and Anchorage Regulations.
