


Interested in joining our team?

Being a firefighter is a challenging job that provides you with self-respect and self-satisfaction. Firefighting requires training, which demands team effort and respect from each firefighter on our department. Mattapoissett Firefighter's are hired as On-Call Firefighters meaning they are issued pagers and respond to the firehouse when a "tone" is sent out signaling an emergency call. Once firefighters arrive at the firehouse, they don their personal protective equipment and then respond on the apparatus.

If chosen for a position as a firefighter, the candidate must be 18yrs of age and able to pass a physical examination, physical agility test, CORI background check and then attend and complete the Massachusetts Firefighting Academy. All selected candidates will be subjected to a probationary period until the completion of the fire academy. The Massachusetts Firefighting Academy is held in Fall River, two nights a week and some weekends.

Training does not end when the fire academy is finished. Mattapoissett Firefighter's train twice a month, on the 2nd and last Thursday for two hours a night and continuously train throughout the year taking extra classes with the Fire Academy or conducting extra in house training with company officers. All training comes at no cost to any member.

The Mattapoissett Fire Department also has a Junior Firefighter Program, which allows anyone between the ages of 16 and 18 to come and work side by side with firefighters during training evolutions and drills. It gives an opportunity for teenagers who possibly have an interest in firefighting, to gain hands on experience in non-life threatening activities. Many firefighter's and company officers have started their careers with Mattapoissett Fire in the Junior Firefighter Program.
