

Highway Department

The year 2013 was another busy year for the Highway Department. We worked a total of 1,476 man hours. During this time our duties included, operating Highway Department equipment for mowing parks and roadsides, collecting trash, replace street signs, sweeping, catch basin and drain cleaning, brush cutting, snow plowing, painting of crosswalks, no parking's, handicapped areas and stop lines. We graded a total of 30.75 miles of public and private dirt roads for 2013.



Snow and Ice Removal

From December 2012 to March 2013 we were called out 35 times for snow and ice removal. This accounted for 1,580 equipment hours and 700 cubic yards of salt /sand.

Road Projects



In the year 2013 an overlay of new blacktop was completed to Mattapoissett Neck Rd. (Bike Path to Antassawamock Rd.) Harbor Rd., Ocean Dr., Whaler's Way and Old Mattapoissett Neck Rd. In addition, Church St. (North St. to Rte.6) Pepperbush Ln. , Linhares Ave, and Jowick St. were completed. Annually, we paint more than 20 miles of yellow center lines on our main roads.




Assist Other Departments
