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NOTES

- 1) *14 Shore Drive* – Septic design approval for design submitted by Schneider, Davignon & Leone Inc. for owner(s) Cynthia & Ronald Axelrod. Designer is requesting approval of variance for the following:
 - a. **310 CMR 15.212 Depth to Ground Water**, requesting variance to design the leaching area 2 ft. above the maximum high ground water rather than the 4ft. requirement. Alternative Technology provided.
 - b. **310 CMR 15.211 Minimum Setback Distance**, requesting variance to install the leaching area 85 ft. from the edge of a Bordering Vegetated Wetland vs. the 100 ft. requirement / requesting variance to install the leaching area 2.8 ft. from the sideline of the Shore Drive layout vs. the 10 ft. requirement / requesting variance to install the leaching area 5 ft. from the existing water service vs. the 10 ft. requirement.

Mr. Bailey moved to accept variances with exception to sleeving the water line.

- 2) *155 Acushnet Road* – Septic design approval for design submitted by Zenith Consulting Engineers LLC for owner(s) Ryan Correia.
