Carmelo Nicolosi opened meeting at 10:09am. Stating that we will have to reschedule due to posting mistake.

- 1) Lot #88 Map #3 Aucoot Road- Schneider, Davignon & Leone, Inc. representing Robert H. Malm. Proposed constructing a complete F.A.S.T de-nitrification treatment unit. The variances requested are:
 - a. 10.01- Leaching Area Setback to a Wetland- Install the leaching area 75 ft from the edge of a bordering vegetated wetland/ island bank of an intermittent stream (drainage ditch) rather than the 100 ft minimum requirement.

Application sent in because of a revised plan on April 16,2021. Cannot make decision due to incorrect posting. Will be addressed next meeting 5-26-2021.

2) Discussion regarding plan of action for Harbor Days.

Bob Saunders reads letter. In the letter he stated there would be certain ways to enter and leave. Traffic will flow in one direction. Take out for food will be encouraged. Tables for eating will be 6ft apart. They will follow safety standards.

Russell Bailey made a motion to bless this event with state restrictions. Ken Dawicki second the motion. Carmelo Nicolosi asked Emily Field's opinion. Field stated that the capacity is a concern and masks are encouraged. Carmelo Nicolosi asked Emily Field about the crowd control. Emily Field responded that she is excited to endorses harbor days and suggested that regulations could change, so be aware of that. Carmelo Nicolosi suggested to Lions Club to continue working with Emily Field. Russell Bailey asked why not move event to August when all restrictions should be gone. Bob Sanders replied that a survey was taken, and they would lose about 35% of vendors.

Which vendors pay for the space which is majority of the money made. Emily Field stated that there would be a conflict with road race if held in August.

Russell Bailey motion to follow state guidelines and line of communication. Ken Dawicki second the motion. All in vote Russell Bailey, Ken Dawicki and Carmelo Nicolosi.

3) Discussion with Mattapoisett Public Health Nurse regarding COVID-19.

Emily Field is concerned with the uptick in cases for two consecutive days. Will do updates to make public aware. 15-year-olds are encouraged to pre-register. Vizor is harder to store vs moderna which is easier. Emily Field is resuming her homebound visits.

- 4) 9 Fairfield Ave- Schneider, Davignon & Leone, Inc. representing Howard C. Chadwick, III. Proposed installing complete system upgrade. The variances requested are:
 - a. 310 CMR 15.104 Percolation Testing- Design the leaching area based on a sieve analysis rather than an actual percolation test.
 - b. 310. CMR 15.211 Minimum Setback Distances- Install the leaching area 8.5 ft from the garage slab foundation rather than the 10 ft requirement.
 - c. 310. CMR 15.212. Depth to Ground Water- Design the leaching facility area 2ft above the maximum high groundwater rather than 4ft requirement using alternative technology.

- 5) Lot #56 Map #14 Brandt Island Road- Schneider, Davignon & Leone, Inc. representing Stephen J. Napolitano. Proposed constructing a complete F.A.S.T de-nitrification treatment unit. The variances requested are:
 - a. 10.01- Leaching Area Setback to a Wetland- Install the leaching area 72 ft from the edge of a bordering vegetated wetland/ island bank of an intermittent stream (drainage ditch) rather than the 100 ft minimum requirement.
