DOT / D.W. White Status: Phase 1B

- The piles arrived on site the week before Thanksgiving. D.W. Whites sub-contractors have driven piles from Goodspeed Island to beyond the breach and now along the marshes at the Mattapoissett River.
- Received email from Ted Nolte, AIA relative to cutting of trees on his property near the western approach to the Mattapoissett River Bridge. His property is at 9 Locus Street. We had a meeting on site, and Stephen is looking into making a planting plan for that area with DOT with the possibility of working with the Mattapoissett Garden Club and the Tree Committee. There isn't any landscape plan in DOT's documents.
