ON-GOING AGENDA ITEMS

CLE Design / Submission Status: Phase 1B

- 100% drawings were being prepared and submitted last month.
- Highway plan submission has been given the go-ahead for 100% drawings by the end of February 2017.
- R.O.W. has requested CLE to move onto 100%. Steve Kelleher met with Mike Gagne last week to review the color-coded site plan for minor changes in R.O.W. Mike noted he would have all the R.O.W. issues hammered out before Town meeting.
- Involvement of Town departments, Committees and Boards – Steve noted that we need more involvement, especially with the Conservation Commission.
- Building Department Head Andy Babola is needed for Town permits for construction
- In a subsequent email from Mike Gagne dated April 14, 2016 with reference to Senator Montigny's office and representative Bill Strauss that the DOT just released the capital plan FY17-22 moving \$4.6 million for the bike path from 2016 to 2017 / 2018.
- CLE and DOT are working towards a November 2017 construction start date.

- Kick-off meeting for Phase Two with District 5 & SRPEDD was held on June 16, 2016 at 2:00 at District 5.
- Bonne is working a private funded 10' wide connector from the Marion town line to the new Mattapoisett water tower that is adjacent to Industrial Drive to connect Marion's Bike Path to Mattapoisett.
