## **ON-GOING AGENDA ITEMS**

CLE Design Status: Phase 1B

- Groundbreaking for Phase 1B was held at the end of Reservation Road at 9:00 on April 25, 2019. The low bidder D.W. White at \$6,645,395.44 delivered heavy equipment to the job site September 3, 2019 to start work.
- Received email from Ted Nolte, AIA relative to cutting of trees on his property near the western approach to the Mattapoisett River Bridge. His property is at 9 Locus Street (see maps).

### Phase Two

- The Bike Path Committee has applied to CPC for \$12,000 for survey of Phase 2 and hopefully wetlands delineation for SRPEDD and DOT District 5. The TIP application requires filing electronically with one user access authority from the Town which Stephen has spoken with Mike Gagne on, and we have a part time librarian Robbin Smith to perform the filing. This was questioned by DOT's Quinn Molloy in respect to librarian requesting GeoDOT accounts, but I called her, and she understood what Mike and I were up to. John Rockwell has volunteered to do the wetlands delineation by the end of November or first of December for free.
- Bonne is working with Mike Gagne on a federal grant from the Marion town line to the existing Mattapoisett park and ride on North Street along a rebuilt Industrial Drive connector with new utilities and a separate bike path lane. The grant is a federal grant for rural areas.
