- 100% drawings were submitted to the Conservation Commission and approved in an October 23, 2017 meeting
- DEP, CLE: Susan Nilson and Jeramy Packard, Steve Kelleher BPC, met on site on 10.12.17 to review on site the marsh crossing at the YMCA / Mattapoisett River.
- Submission of the first structural plans was on 8/17/17.
- Approval of first structural plans will be at the end of November 2017.
- Filing Chapter 91 waterways after Order of Conditions are received from Conservation Commission.
- Categorical exclusion is awaiting CZM and Chapter 91 licensing.
- Special Town Meeting on 11/27/17: Article 17 Easement and Bike Path Acquisition Expenses \$55,000 passed 101 to 2.
