- DOT / D.W. White Status: Phase 1B DW White has installed a partial deck area with a thicker boarding as a test area for decking that has failed. Selectman have approved its installation. Steve has contacted IPE USA and they have one-piece thicker plank that would support an ambulance. Stephen has a sample. The new 5" deck is to be installed
- Partial opening of Phase1B at the marsh crossing this summer seems to be working.
